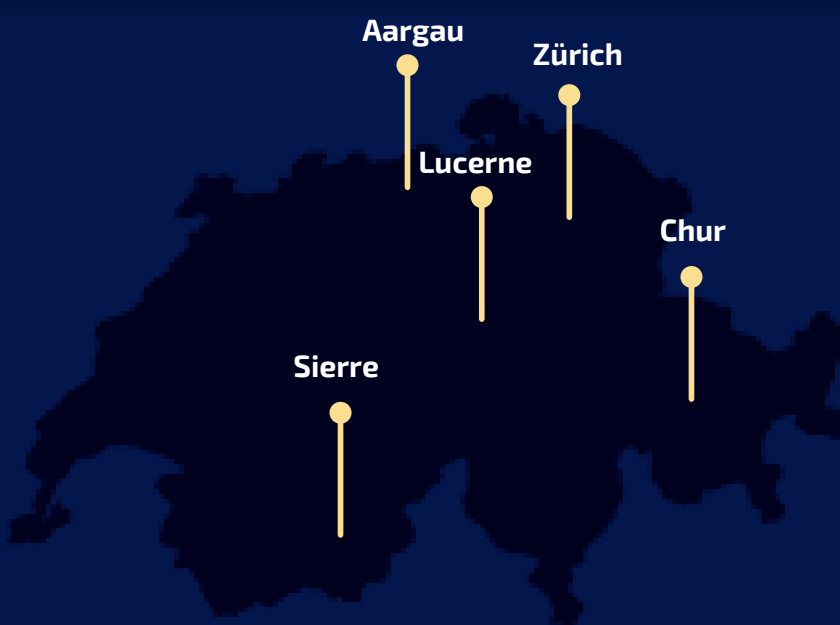


# SWITZERLAND

Switzerland has a population of 8.8 million people. It is bordered by Italy to the south, France to the west, Germany to the north and Austria and Liechtenstein to the east. The largest cities include Zürich, Geneva and Basel.



## agreeableness

High rates are: Lucerne, Chur, Zürich, Aargau and Sierre

Predominately German speaking.

## neuroticism

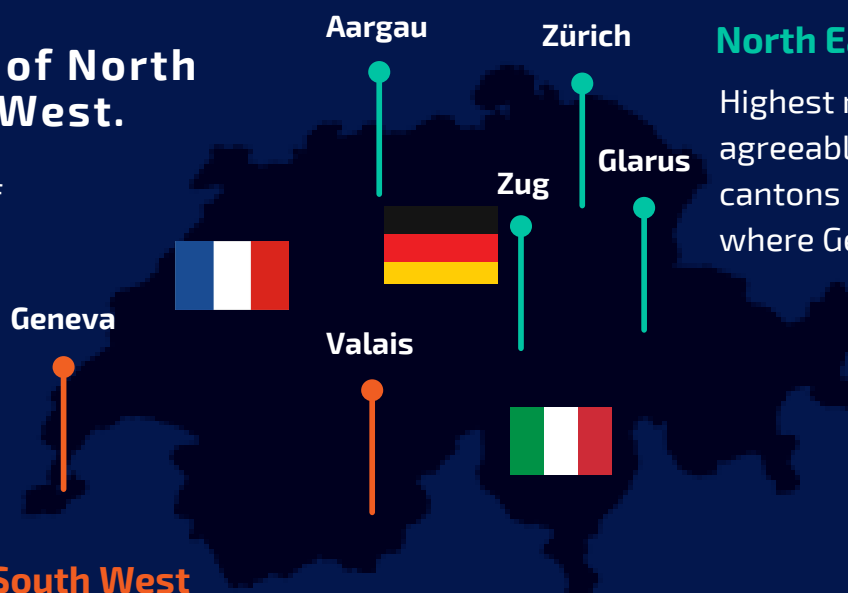
Higher rates of neuroticism are: Fribourg, Valais, Geneva and the Italian-speaking Ticino.

Low rates are: Schaffhausen and in the German-speaking Eastern cantons.



## German divides of North East and South West.

Whereas **South West** of the German speaking population tend to have higher scores of neuroticism than their counterparts of the **North East** region including Aargau, Zug and Zürich.



## North East

Highest rates of agreeableness includes cantons of **North East**, where German is spoken.



## South West

The Italian-speaking Ticino shows low rates of Agreeableness.

Meanwhile the bilingual **South West** (Italian and French) Valais to Geneva are slightly above the **average levels** of agreeableness.
